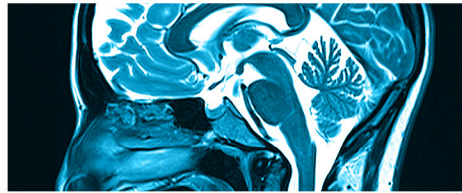

The Manufacturing Engineer will be responsible to provide front end support during product development by working closely with engineers and designers to develop processes, procedures and instructions for the assembly, test, packaging and labeling of IMRIS product.
